REGULATIONS

for the 1st International Children's Ceramics Contest

“Magic from the Fire”

1.General terms.

Present Regulation determines the objectives, the procedure and the conditions for holding the 1st International Children's Ceramics Contest "Magic from the fire". (hereinafter “Contest”)

The contest organizers are: Federation of European Association of Stovemakers Handicraft - VEUKO, «Children's art school» Petrozavodsk and Petrozavodsk City Administration, Department of Culture and «Citylink IT company».

Multilingual Internet resource (hereinafter – “Contest Website”) is to be launched in order to arrange a virtual exhibition and to provide information about the contest, as well. www.magicfromfire.com

2.Goals and objectives.

- to arrange the ceramics exhibition both within the premises of the Children's Art School and its virtual exhibition on the Contest Website.

- to search for and provide further assistance for the gifted children in the field of applied arts;
- to develop and popularize children's creativity, to raise its level and quality;
- to contribute to the development of children's and teenager's creative abilities;
- to shape a well-integrated personality possessing high spiritual and moral values in children;
- to boost interest in traditional folk crafts;
- to introduce children to the traditions of other countries and regions, to build mutually friendly relations.

3.Participants.

The Contest is open to students of state and non-state educational institutions aged 14 to 17 years.

The age of the participants is determined on January, 1st, 2018.

4.Jury.

The Jury of the Contest will be comprised of professional artists and art experts and personalities in the field of arts and crafts, representatives from the participating countries.

The final list of judges will be available on the Contest Website no later than November, 30th, 2018.

The Chairperson is Vladimir Viktorovich Zorin (the chairman and the member of "Union of Russian Artists", Honored Artist of the Republic of Karelia).

All the works submitted will have numbers. The Jury of the Contest won't know personal information of participants. Each of Jury will estimate work on a scale from 1 to 10 (10 is the best result). 3 works which will get the greatest points become prize-winners of a competition. If works will have the identical number of points, then the winner will be defined by the Chairperson.

5.The subject, requirements and restrictions of the Contest.

Participants who wish to participate in the Contest may submit a work on the subject "Winter Tale". The subject can be revealed through the images of the winter nature, the life of the city or village, winter holidays, entertainments, leisure activities, etc. Works submitted have to be realized in the form of plates of any form of ceramic materials (clay, chamotte, earthenware, etc.). The size of plates has to be limited between 18 to 25 cm. Decoration of works is permitted in the classical ceramic methods only: glazes, enamels, blackening, engobes, etc. The "cold painting" isn't allowed. Works have to:

- to comply with the subject of the contest;
- to be personally created and originally designed;
- to be expressive and figurative concerning art;

The participant is obliged to attach the application form (Appendix 1).

Each participant may submit no more than 2 works.

Consider delivery periods of a parcel, please. We recommend to send parcels before November, 5th, 2018.

6.Course of the Contest.

There are three stages of the Contest:

Stage 1. November, 5th – November, 30th, 2018 – the participants send their works. The delivery of works is carried out (via post services or otherwise) to the Children's art school of Petrozavodsk: 185035, Republic of Karelia, Petrozavodsk, Krasnoarmeyskaya St., house 18. (the sender is to cover all the postage expenses). the sender is to cover all the postage expenses).

Stage 2. December, 3rd – December, 7th, 2018 - the Jury chooses the works entitled to the reward and participation in the final exhibition.

Stage 3. December, 10th – December, 20th, 2018 - organizational arrangements. December, 21st – closing award ceremony, the opening ceremony of the final exhibition (Children's Art School). The exhibition will last till January, 31st, 2019.

7. Prizes.

Winners of the contest will get the following cash bonuses:

The 1st place - €800

The 2nd place - €600

The 3rd place - €400

The prize will be paid out by the Federation of European Associations of Stovemakers Handicraft - VEUKO

Methods of payment will be coordinated with each prize-winner independently.

Payments to the prize-winners from the Russian Federation will be paid in rubles at the rate set by the Central Bank of the Russian Federation on the date of payment.

State and public organizations, artistic unions, mass media, institutions and companies may establish special prizes with the approval of the Jury.

The winners of the Contest will be invited to the opening ceremony of the final exhibition (the sender is to cover all the travelling and living expenses).

All the participants of the final exhibition will be awarded the diplomas.

All the diplomas of other regions and countries will be sent there by e-mail (the one stated in the application form) as a scanned copy.

Attention!

All the works submitted are not to be returned after the Contest. They will be stored in the fund of the "Children's art school" in Petrozavodsk.

Having submitted works to the Contest, the authors (adult participants), parents or lawful guardians of the authors (underage participants) and the educational institutions (in charge of teaching the participants) thereby agree with the Contest Terms stated in this Regulation and consent to the use of their work pictures on the

Internet and in various printed media with the author's surname given.
